Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing respondent Nos.4 and 6 to adjust the petitioner as per policy instructions Annexure P-3 dated 05.11.2018 and Annexure P-6 dated 11.09.2019 as Guest Faculty in stream of Mechanical Engineering against available workload as per advertisement Annexure P-4 dated August, 2019.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has filed representation Annexure P-5 dated 20.08.2019 in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided and the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-5 dated 20.08.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed

of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-5 dated 20.08.2019 in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
