Petitioner has filed the present revision petition against the order dated 25.09.2019 passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Nuh, whereby on an application filed by the respondent seeking interim maintenance, a sum of Rs.5,000/- per month has been granted to the respondent, who is minor daughter of the petitioner, as interim maintenance.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in fact the mother of the respondent is using this maintenance despite the fact that she has solemnized marriage with some other person and the petitioner has also filed a petition seeking custody of the respondent with the competent court.

Heard.

It is not in dispute that the respondent is daughter of the petitioner and the petitioner has solemnized second marriage. For survival of the respondent, the awarded maintenance is certainly not on higher side for the reason that the petitioner and his earlier wife (mother of the respondent), both have statedly re-married.

As regard the argument of counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has filed a petition seeking custody of the respondent, he is at liberty to pursue such petition and in case such like petition has been filed, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to expedite those proceedings.

Dismissed.
