This petition has been filed for violation of statement made in this Court in COCP No. 1181 of 2018. The contempt petition was disposed of on 19.9.2019 in view of the statement made that interest to petitioner No.1 shall be released within six weeks from today.

The grievance raised in the present petition is that needful has not been done.

Today learned counsel for the parties are *ad-idem* that the amount have been credited to the account of the petitioner on 27.11.2019, however, learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is delay in doing the needful.

Learned counsel for respondents submits that the delay occurred because of technical reason as the amount was lying with the bank, as there was calculation error and the matter was not being processed. After doing the needful the same was credited. The explanation given for delay is accepted.

In view of the above fact, as the needful has been done, the contempt petition is disposed of.
