MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (Oral)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.199 dated 05.08.2018 (P-1), under Sections 147, 149, 323, 324, 326 and 341 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

This Court, on the previous date of hearing i.e. 08.01.2019, passed the following order:-

“ It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that it is a version and cross version case as the petitioners side have also suffered injuries in the same very occurrence. Further contends that even the matter was compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel seeks time to verify the above facts.

On his request, adjourned to 12.02.2019 for further consideration.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of

their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, ASI Subhash Chander submits that petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of order dated 08.01.2019 and their custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, interim order dated 08.01.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioners shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
