Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.117 dated 27.11.2018 (P-1), under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Rupnagar.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 27.12.2018, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that in FIR No. 117 dated 27.11.2018 the allegations are only against Avtar Singh, who happens to be the real brother of the petitioner. Further contends that petitioner is already married and living separately.

Notice of motion for 12.02.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of her arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit her to interim bail till the next date of hearing on her furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to

abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, ASI Deepak Kumar submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 27.12.2018 and her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, interim order dated 27.12.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
