Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was appointed as Chowkidar for 89 days in the year 1996 and he has continuously been working as such ever since but since March, 2019, he has not been paid salary despite work being taken from him. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P/3 dated 18.09.2019 as well as legal notice Annexure P/4 dated 26.09.2019 but the same have not been decided till date and in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/4 dated 26.09.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

2. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is

disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/4 dated 26.09.2019, in accordance with law, within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
