Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.267 dated 01.10.2017, under Sections 379, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 27.12.2018, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that the petitioner is a truck driver and due to unavoidable circumstances could not appear on 25.10.2018 before the learned trial Court. Further contends that this is the only lapse on the part of the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 12.02.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court and would be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction. The petitioner is also

*directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under
Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”*

Today, H.C. Jaskaran Singh, Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda submits that in pursuance of order dated 27.12.2018, petitioner has joined the proceedings before learned trial Court on 14.01.2019.

In view of above, interim order dated 27.12.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and would not repeat such lapse(s) in future. Also directed that petitioner shall not seek unnecessary adjournments.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
