Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.292 dated 07.11.2018 under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 20.02.2019:-

“.....Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is neither a travel agent nor has any dealing with the complainant and she has been implicated in the FIR only because she is a sister of co-accused – Narinder Kumar.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer has submitted that the petitioner be directed to join the investigation.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Puran Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
