The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 249 dated 10.11.2018 under Sections 365, 148, 149, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Dugri, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant has not suffered any injury, infact there is a dispute going on between the complainant and co-accused Garry Bhardwaj and the petitioner has been falsely implicated. Thus, anticipatory bail be granted to him.

Learned State counsel submits that vide order dated 14.12.2018 passed in CRM-M-54414-2018, anticipatory bail petition of identically situated co-accused Garry Bhardwaj has already been dismissed. That apart, the petitioner is accused of serious offence of kidnapping the complainant and wrongfully confining him, thus, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

While the order was being dictated, learned counsel for the petitioner has made a prayer for withdrawal of the petition.

The prayer is accepted and the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
