[1] Learned counsel contends that prayer is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for grant of 2nd ACP due from 09.03.2016, as also for consideration of the claim of the petitioner for voluntary retirement submitted vide application (Annexure P-5) dated 20.04.2018.

[2] Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has already served a legal notice (Annexure P-7) dated 02.08.2019 in respect of the aforementioned claims but the same has not been decided, till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claims made in the legal notice (Annexure P-7) dated 02.08.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claims of the petitioner, as made in the legal notice (Annexure P-7) dated 02.08.2019, in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible on receipt of certified copy of this order.
