Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had married to respondent No.4 on 11.11.2017. According to the petitioner, since respondent No.4 was suffering from mental disorder, she was taken back by her parents. A petition dated 10.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act for annulment of marriage before the District Judge, Patiala, was filed by the petitioner. It is further contended that now the petitioner is receiving threats from respondent No.4 and her father that she will commit suicide and entire family of the petitioner will be implicated in false case.

Let the petitioner along with written application appear before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, who shall look into the same in accordance with law expeditiously.
