This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. moved in FIR No. 533 dated 27.10.2018 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 313 and 34 IPC, Police Station Baldev Nagar Ambala.

The brief allegations are that marriage between petitioner and the complainant took place on 01.12.2016 and the harassment, cruelty and physical abuse by petitioner led to the abortion of the

pregnancy of the complainant. The complainant has further alleged that the accused including the petitioner had usurped the articles of her 'istridhan' leading to the registration of the case.

Mr. S.K. Garg Narwana, Senior Advocate assisted by Mr. Sumit Gupta, Advocate submits that the parties have effected a settlement and that in view of this settlement, the petitioner deserves the concession of anticipatory bail.

Mr. Amrik Narwal, DAG, Haryana assisted by Mr. A.K. Lamdharia, Advocate for the complainant and ASI Sunil Kumar Police Station Baldev Nagar does not dispute the facts but has conceded that the parties have effected a settlement in this criminal dispute.

Appreciating these stands and in the light of the statement made before this Court by complainant and in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is admitted to the anticipatory bail and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
