A sum of Rs.1,50,000/- has been handed over in cash to the complainant, who has received the same. As is reflected from the records nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

In view of the above and what is apparent from the records that nothing is to be re-covered from the the petitioner, the petitioner shall join the investigation and consequent upon his doing so, the order of interim bail shall be made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
