[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to prepare a seniority list of Extension Lecturers in the subject of Physics in respondent No.3/*College* in the light of circular (Annexure P-7) dated 13.07.2018 and further to prepare merit list as per selection criteria (Annexure P-10) dated 29.09.2017.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-11) dated 09.08.2019, but the same has not been decided, till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage, by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-11) dated 09.08.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed as per representation

(Annexure P-11) dated 09.08.2019, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-11) dated 09.08.2019, in accordance with law within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
