Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus to direct the respondents to issue the displaced letter and re-engage the petitioner in the respondent-College or in a nearby Government College having workload and vacancy and also to pay remuneration at the rate of Rs.1000/- per period instead of Rs.200/250 paid to the petitioner for the period she worked as per details given in the writ petition as also to pay arrears of remuneration for the academic session 2012-2013 and 2013-2014 for notional break and vacations period.

2. Learned counsel contends that the respondents have issued instructions Annexure P-7 dated 16.09.2019 regarding adjustment of displaced extension lecturer and that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P-13 dated 15.10.2019 but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to

consider and decide the claim made in the representation Annexure P-13 dated 15.10.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim made in the representation Annexure P-13 dated 15.10.2019 in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
