Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition. He has further submitted that the Trial Court where the complaint No. DV ACT/184, dated 5.10.2019, under Sections 12, 13, 14, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is pending, may be directed to probe the possibility of some amicable settlement since the parties at one point of time had actually entered into a compromise and had also decided to get their marriage dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent although later the respondent withdrew her consent for divorce.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn. Since the matter has apparently arisen out of matrimonial

discord amongst the parties, therefore, it would certainly be appropriate if another effort is made for probing the possibility of compromise. The Trial Court, as such is directed to make such an effort. The parties may also be referred to Mediator for the said purpose.
