The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.181, dated 02.07.2017 under Sections 174-A, 415 of IPC, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier, the petitioner had been granted regular bail but he could not appear subsequently because of ill health and his bail bonds were cancelled. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on each and every date of hearing and he will not evade the court proceedings without prior permission of the court.

This Court, by the order dated 27.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was to be released on *ad-interim* bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned State counsel states that in terms of order dated 27.11.2019, the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court on 10.12.2019 and has been granted *ad interim* bail. He has furnished a copy of the order dated 10.12.2019 passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ellenabad, which is taken on record.

In view of the above and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail, the order dated 27.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
