Despite repeated adjournments, nobody is appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the matter has not been argued since filing of the petition in January, 2019.

Otherwise also, the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for quashing of F.I.R. No.210 dated 04.08.2017 under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'IPC') and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur including all subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise.

As per view taken by Hon'ble Apex Court in Criminal Appeal No.14 of 2019 arising out of S.L.P. (Criminal) No.5632 of 2014—**State of Madhya Pradesh Vs. Kalyan Singh and others**, present petition for quashing of F.I.R. on the basis of compromise, is not maintainable.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
