This order shall stand disposed of two petitions bearing CRM-M-56856-2018 and CRM-M-41104-2018.

Prayer in both the above-mentioned petitions is to direct conducting of fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.0176

dated 26.05.2018 registered under Sections 148/149/323/506 IPC

(Sections 324/326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

On 02.05.2019, following order was passed:-

“After hearing arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner in both the petitions, it is considered appropriate to direct Superintendent of Police, Charki Dadri to examine all the documents along with contention raised in these petitions and thereafter, submit a status report within 3 weeks from today.

Adjourned to 28.05.2019.

The petitioners would also be given opportunity of hearing by the Superintendent of Police.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of other connected case.”

Pursuant to the above-said order, affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri has been filed .

It has been stated by the learned counsel for the State that offence under Section 326 IPC has been deleted; investigations are complete and challan against both the parties is being presented.

Hence, parties are relegated to the remedy before the Magistrate where police report is submitted.

In view of the above, both these petitions stand disposed of.
