Petitioner-Beant Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to the official respondent to take legal action against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as the private respondents have carried no development in the village, therefore, FIR should be registered against them. She further invited the attention of the Court to the representation dated 17.09.2019 (Annexure P-1).

Perusal of the representation reveals that it was not given to the Police Officer and is addressed to the Director Public Instruction, (Elementary), SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab. Even otherwise, the petition and the representation lack necessary facts and particulars, therefore, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
