Prayer in the petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0045 dated 01.06.2019 registered under Sections 323, 365, 376, 511 of IPC (Sections 379-B, 386, 120-B and 216 IPC added later on) at Women Police Station, Kurukshetra.

Record reveals that the present application was filed on 25.11.2019.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Paramjeet Kaur states that after filing this petition before this Court, the petitioner has filed second application so as to seek regular bail before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra on 30.11.2019. As per instructions, the petitioner was admitted on bail on 02.12.2019. She submits that in the second application filed before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, the factum of present petition was never mentioned in the application filed by the petitioner. She produced a photocopy of the application.

Heard.

The present application has been filed on 25.11.2019 and thereafter second application for regular bail has been filed before the learned Additional Sessions Judge on 30.11.2019 without disclosing the fact that the present petition filed by the petitioner is pending before this Court for the same relief.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed with a cost of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana High Court.
