Application is allowed as prayed for. Annexures P-14 is taken on record.

Main case

1. Learned State counsel fairly submits that rationalisation of transfer policy is in process and the same is likely to be finalised within two months.
2. Without commenting on the merits of the case, writ petition is disposed of with an observation that keeping in view the vacancy position as reflected from Annexure P-14 the competent authority shall pass fresh orders by treating the present writ petition as a representation, subject of course to rationalisation of transfer policy which is in the process of being finalised.
3. It would be appreciated if the competent authority would pass order by taking a sympathetic view that on the one hand the petitioner has been dislodged from his current place, on the other hand, his salary has been reduced from Rs.42,800/- per month to Rs.15,300 per month, therefore, it would be harsh on him to relocate in his current salary.
4. Let the needful be done within a period of 2 months.
