Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 216 dated 15.09.2019 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that alleged recovery from the petitioner is of 200 narcotics capsules of Parvorin Spas (Ridely) weighing 128.2 grams, which is non-commercial. He further states that parameters laid down in the NDPS Act has not been complied with and the petitioner is in custody since 15.09.2019.

On the instructions from ASI Rajbir Singh, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that challan has been presented, charges has been framed and prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
