Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.1148 dated 15.10.2019, under Sections 323, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station city Thanesar, District Kurukshetra. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 15.10.2019.

The FIR in the present case was registered on the statement of complainant Manpreet Kaur wherein it was alleged that on 14.10.2019, when she was present at her house where his brother-in-law (*Devar*), namely, Arjun Singh quarreled with her and beaten her up with belt and when he was about to cause injury to her with a stone, she was rescued by neighbors. The accused had also threatened to kill her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the compromise has been effected between the petitioner and respondent No.2. He submits

that the final report has been filed and the trial of the case is likely to

consume some time, therefore, further custody of the petitioner may not be required.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ramesh Chand as well as Learned counsel for respondent No.2 admit the factum of compromise.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the opinion that trial of the case is likely to consume considerable time, and the offence is triable by the Magistrate, therefore, further custody of the petitioner may not be justified. Resultantly, without meaning any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court Kurukshetra.

The petition is allowed.
