Prayer in the writ petition is for regularization of the services of the petitioners as per Policy Annexure P-1 dated 1.10.2003.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioners have served legal notice Annexure P-7 dated 19.07.2018 in respect of the claim for regularization but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-7 dated 19.07.2018 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the claim, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-7 dated 19.07.2018 in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
