By way of instant petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the non-practicing allowance of the petitioners, who are Punjab Civil Medical Services doctors and undergoing Post Graduate courses in Government Medical Colleges, in accordance with judgment dated 23.07.2019 (Annexure P-5) passed by this Court. The petitioners also submitted separate representations dated 23.07.2019 (Annexure P-7 and P-8 respectively), but the same have not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. P. S. Bajwa, Additional Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representations dated 23.07.2019 (Annexure P-7 and P-8) also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
