Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though the prayer made in the present writ petition is for quashing the show cause notices dated 29.11.2018 and 18.12.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-3 respectively) but the petitioner is not pressing the said prayer and will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said show cause notices in a time bound manner as the pendency of the said show cause notices is causing prejudice to the petitioner as the pensionary benefits of the petitioner have been withheld.

Notice of motion.

Keeping in view the advance copies supplied by the petitioner, Ms. Sunint Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned counsel for the respondents raises

no objection for the grant of prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner for passing appropriate orders deciding the show cause notices dated 29.11.2018 and 18.12.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-3 respectively) in a time bound manner. Learned counsel for the respondents states that the appropriate order in respect of the show cause notices dated 29.11.2018 and 18.12.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-3 respectively) will be passed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the statement given by learned counsel for the respondents, petitioner does not wish to press this writ petition any further.

Disposed of as not pressed.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner is aggrieved against the final order passed in respect of the show cause notices dated 29.11.2018 and 18.12.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-3 respectively), she will be at liberty to avail her appropriate remedy as envisaged under the law.
