ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.156 dated 08.10.2018, under Section 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Kotakpura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated as she is wife of the co-accused who along with other accused was partner of the company which had accepted a sum of Rs.7,13,350/- from the complainant for doubling the same in 3 years. He further contends that the petitioner is a lady with a 5 year old minor child. She is in custody for over 4 months. Her husband is also in custody. She is not involved in any other case.

Custody certificate filed by the learned State counsel is taken on record. He, upon instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh, states that although charges have been framed but none of the prosecution witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when petitioner is a lady with a minor child, she is not involved in any other case, she is in custody for over 4 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
