The petitioners filed a writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents (in the writ petition) to re-fix and re-calculate the retiral benefits. The writ petition was disposed of on 6.9.2018 directing Director General of Police, Punjab to decide the legal notice of the petitioners.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Learned counsel for the State has produced orders dated 28.11.2018, 29.11.2018, 30.11.2018, 3.12.2018, 4.12.2018 and 6.12.2018 whereby the claims of the petitioners have been rejected. He submits that the said orders were sent to the petitioners through registered post and the same fact has not been mentioned in the contempt petition.

In view of the above, no further interference is called for in the present contempt petition.

Dismissed.
