The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents (in the writ petition) to re-fix and re-calculate the retiral benefits. The writ petition was disposed of on 27.7.2018 directing Director General of Police, Punjab to decide the legal notice of the petitioner.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Learned counsel for the State has produced order dated 17.10.2018 whereby the claim of the petitioner has been rejected. He submits that the said order was sent to the petitioner through registered post and the same fact has not been mentioned in the contempt petition.

In view of the above, no further interference is called for in the present contempt petition.
