Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR NO.0209, dated 03.09.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner after seeing the police party had thrown a packet of intoxicant and tried to run away. The packet was found containing 270 gram intoxicating powder, 580 Alprazolam tablets, syringes and other articles.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, has submitted that the petitioner is a habitual offender and involved in as many as 9 more cases, out of which 8 are under the NDPS Act.

In view thereof, this court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
