Learned counsel for the respondents while producing an order passed by the respondents on 18.04.2019 states that the services starting from 01.06.1993 till 10.11.1999 and 01.06.1993 till 13.07.2000 qua petitioners No. 1 and 2 respectively have been treated as qualifying service for pensionary benefits. Copy of the order passed to this effect has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.
