This is a second bail application for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.277, dated 15.12.2018, registered under Sections 147/149/323/307/506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad, Haryana.

As per the case of the first informant, Ajay, who was having a pistol, had fired a shot with the intention to kill, but since the first informant fell on the ground so bullet passed over his head.

On 04.12.2019, this court was informed that the parties have now settled the dispute and the FIR was registered under a wrong impression. Affidavit of the first informant-victim was also filed. Hence, first informant was directed to remain present in Court.

Today, first informant is present in Court, identified by his counsel as well as by the Investigating Officer.

Investigations are complete. Police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed in Court.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 22.01.2019 and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
