The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.79 dated 29.06.2019 registered under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 28.11.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, the police party apprehended the co-accused namely Amninder Singh and 10 gms of smack was recovered from his possession. It is further submitted that the petitioner was nominated as an accused on the basis of the disclosure statement of the aforesaid coaccused – Amninder Singh.

Notice of motion for 18.12.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 28.11.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI

Sukhpal Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 28.11.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
