ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.117 dated 24.07.2019, under Sections 379-B (2), 34 and 411 of IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is stated that two persons who had come with their faces covered had taken away a gold 'kara' and ear rings. He further contends that the identification of the petitioner is in doubt. The petitioner is not involved in any other case. He is in custody for about 4 ½ months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Avinash Rai, states that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when petitioner is in custody for about 4 ½ months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
