ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

By way of this petition, petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash selection result dated 17.05.2016 (Annexure P-3) for the post of Technical Officer-1 (Equipment Maintenance), whereby allegedly an ineligible candidate has been selected.

2. Having heard the rival contentions and upon perusal of petition and record appended thereto I am of the view that there are highly disputed questions of facts involved herein. In as much as, the petitioner contends that not only the selected candidate, i.e. respondent No.4 was ineligible for appointment for lacking the basic qualification as per advertisement but his candidature was also initially rejected. Yet, in violation thereof, he was later on invited for interview and has been selected.

3. Be that as it may, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the extraordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution and the petitioner is at liberty to seek appropriate remedy with regard to the

disputed questions of facts contained herein including filing of the civil suit,
if so advised.

The writ petition stands dismissed.
