The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.208 dated 07.07.2018 registered under Sections 15(c) of the Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad, for attending marriage of sister and brother of the petitioner which are to be performed from 30.11.2019 to 02.12.2019.

Perusal of the order passed by the court below shows that the petitioner has already been permitted to be taken to the marriage on the date of marriage. There is no ground to extend the said concession.

Otherwise also, the marriage is stated to be fixed for Monday, i.e., 02.12.2019. Even if this court intends to interfere in favour of the petitioner, still no time is left. Needless to say that before passing any interim order, the State would be required to verify the facts regarding the marriage and necessity of the petitioner at the said marriage

beyond 02.12.2019, as has been permitted by the court below. There is no time left for such verification at this stage.

In that view of the matter, the petition stands dismissed.
