The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.119 dated 22.06.2019 under Sections 392, 395, 447, 511, 427, 506, 186, 146, 148, 149 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

Vide order dated 27.11.2019, an interim protection was granted to petitioners No.1 and 2, namely Jaswinder Kaur and Harbhajan Kaur and it was directed that if the Investigating Officer does not actually join them in the investigation, they would appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate immediately, who would then summon the arresting officer and direct him to join them in investigation, in terms of the order of this Court.

Thereafter, on 19.12.2019, it was informed to the Court that the petitioners have not joined the investigation nor they have appeared before the Illaqa Magistrate. However, still interim protection was

granted and it was made clear that if any request for an adjournment is made on behalf of the counsel for the petitioners then that would entail immediate vacation of the interim order and it was also made clear that if the State counsel informs the Court that they have not joined investigation, that would also entail automatic vacation of the interim order.

Today Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG Punjab, on instructions of ASI Kewal Singh, submits that both the petitioners, namely, Jaswinder Kaur and Harbhajan Kaur have already joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from them. Therefore, their custodial investigation is not required.

In view of the above the present petition stands allowed qua petitioner No.1 and 2 only.

The order dated 19.12.2019, whereby interim protection was granted to petitioner No.1 and 2 is hereby made absolute.
