ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.102 dated 08.09.2019, under Sections 306, 506 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR do not constitute prima facie case under Section 306 IPC. He further contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on account of misunderstanding between the parties which has now been resolved. He also contends that it is alleged that the petitioner and the co-accused had beaten up Harbir Singh and they had falsely alleged that he was having an illicit relationship due to which Harbir Singh committed suicide. He also contends that there was no injury on the person of the deceased. The petitioner is in custody for over 3 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Balbir Singh, states that challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 3 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
