Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner retired as Class-IV employee on attaining the age of superannuation on 30.06.2017, but the benefits, for which the petitioner is entitled in respect of the services rendered by her, have not been released to the petitioner so far without there being any impediment in release of the same.

Prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 for releasing the pensionary benefits by passing appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner served respondents No.3 and 4 with a legal notice dated 23.09.2019 (Annexure P-1), which is still pending consideration with respondents No.3 and 4 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.4—The Secretary, Municipal Council, Narwana, Jind, to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 23.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the decision, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to her within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
