Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner on the post of TGT Punjabi with effect from the date juniors to the petitioner have been promoted. Prayer is also for the issuance of directions to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice Annexure P-6 dated 16.10.2019 in the light of judgments Annexure P-7 (collectively) dated 12.09.2018.

2. Learned counsel states that the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-6 dated 16.10.2019 has not been decided till date, and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of, at this stage, by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-6 dated 16.10.2019 in the light of decision of this Court Annexure P-7 (collectively) dated 12.09.2018 in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-6 dated 16.10.2019 in accordance with the rules applicable as well as the decision of this Court Annexure P-7 (collectively) dated 12.09.2018 in case the same is applicable within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
