The petitioner has submitted that despite FIR No.168, dated 23.9.2019, registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 306, 511 IPC having been lodged at the instance of the petitioner in the month of September, 2019, no effective investigation has been conducted in the matter pertaining to death of the petitioner's daughter.

Learned counsel has submitted that the grand-father of the accused i.e. respondent No.9 happens to be Chairman, Block Samiti, Samrala, who has been making attempts to exercise influence to hamper the investigation due to which the investigation is not making any headway.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the allegations leveled in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Mini Secretariat, Ludhiana (respondent No.2) to ensure that the FIR in question is got investigated expeditiously in accordance with law preferably by a Senior Officer since the petitioner alleges that respondent No.9 is trying to influence the investigation.

A copy of this order be sent to Commissioner of Police, Mini Secretariat, Ludhiana (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
