Petitioner-Manjinder Singh @ Manu Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.199 dated 24.12.2018 registered under Sections 307, 323 and 506 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

The FIR was registered on the statement of complainant, namely, Gurdial Singh @ Matta wherein it was alleged that when the complainant along with Jassa Singh went to the house of Manjinder Singh @ Manu (petitioner) on motorcycle for taking back his sword (khunda), then petitioner abused them and gave threats to kill. When they reached near Bridge Tadeawala Khadur Sahib, then petitioner armed with country made pistol alongwith Sajan Singh came on motorcycle and fired shot. The gun shot hit Jassa Singh on left elbow and accomplices of petitioner gave datar

blow on the right hand of the complainant. On raising noise, all assailants ran away from the spot. On these broad allegations, FIR was registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He submits that the injuries suffered by the complainant are simple in nature.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the prayer on the ground that the petitioner is specifically named in the FIR who was armed with weapon and fired gunshot. It is further pointed out that the petitioner is involved in seven other cases.

Considering the nature of offence, this Court does not find any valid reason for grant of extraordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
