Learned counsel makes an oral prayer for permission to delete the name of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana/respondent No.2 from the array of respondents.

2. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the name of Chief Minister, Haryana is ordered to be deleted from the array of respondents.

3. Registry to make necessary correction in the memo of parties.

4. Learned counsel states that the Chief Minister, Haryana had ordered action to be taken against respondent Nos.6 and 7 on account of respondent Nos.6 and 7 having obtained M.Sc degree in a fraudulent manner but no action has been taken in the matter even though the petitioner has also made a representation Annexure P-3 dated Nil besides served legal notice Annexure P-4 dated 15.11.2019. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.1 to

consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-4 dated 15.11.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-4 dated 15.11.2019 in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
