Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.95 dated 21.9.2019 registered under Section 17 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner on seeing the police party was trying to run away but apprehended and disclosed that he is in possession of 100 grams opium and himself produced it to the police party.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Dilbagh Singh states that the quantity recovered does not fall in commercial category and petitioner is not involved in any other case of the like nature.

Petitioner is in custody since 21.9.2019. Conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to

the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
