Prayer in the writ petition is for setting aside/modification of seniority list Annexure P-4 reflecting list of Assistants promoted upto 31.01.2017 as employees junior to the petitioner have been mentioned as senior in the same without any lawful justification.

2. Learned counsel contends that the seniority list was circulated vide Memo No.1-70/P.O/E.A-4/2173-76 dated 15.04.2019 inviting objections within a period of one month and that although the petitioner filed objections Annexure P-5 dated 7.5.2019 but the same have not been decided till date.

3. Learned counsel states the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of, at this stage, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the objections Annexure P-5 dated 7.5.2019 against seniority list Annexure P-4 circulated vide Memo No. dated 15.04.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Without commenting upon the merits of the claim, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the objections Annexure P-5 dated 7.5.2019 as filed by the petitioner against seniority list Annexure P-4 circulated vide Memo No.1-70/P.O/E.A-4/2173-76 dated 15.04.2019 by the Superintendent on behalf of the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
