The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.745 dated 8.12.2018, registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, District Rohtak, under Section 379-A IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested on 6.8.2019 and that although, the challan has been presented, but examination of PWs has not yet commenced and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. Thus, the petitioner may be released on regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 14.12.2019, prepared by Sh. Sewa Singh, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Rohtak, has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 04 months and 09 days and there 06 other criminal cases pending against him. All of them are under Section 379-A IPC, as the instant case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the remaining cases were foisted upon the petitioner after he was arrested in one case. The petitioner has been granted bail in the remaining cases.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
