[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to release arrears of pay and other benefits in the light of Order (Annexure P-6) dated 28.05.2019, passed by the Director General (Secondary Education).

[2] Learned counsel contends that the petitioners were regularized on different dates in the year 2017-18 vide Order (Annexure P-6) dated 28.05.2019 and the Director General (Secondary Education) directed all Principals, DEOs and BEOs to grant arrears of pay on regularization of part time Class IV employees, but no action has been taken in respect thereto by respondent Nos.3 & 4, despite the petitioners having served legal notice (Annexure P-7) colly. dated 14.08.2019.

[3] Learned counsel states that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent Nos.3 & 4 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-7) collectively dated 14.08.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

[4] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claim, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent Nos.3 & 4 to decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-7) collectively dated 14.08.2019, in accordance with law by taking into account all aspects of the matter within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
