Petitioners have filed this criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty and provide police protection to them as they have entered into a marriage against the wishes of private respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners were known to each other for the last four years and they married each other on 24.11.2019. It is argued that the petitioners are apprehending threat from the widowed mother of Jaspreet Kaur (petitioner No.1) and others including grand-father.

During the course of the hearing, it is not disputed that the mother of petitioner No.1 did not agree for the marriage, however, at that stage no threat was extended to the petitioners. According to learned counsel for the petitioners, threat was extended after the marriage was solemnized

between the parties.

A perusal of the petition and the representation dated 25.11.2019 does not reveal any manner or mode of threat allegedly extended to the petitioners. The contents of the petition do not inspire confidence.

Petition is dismissed.
