[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondent-Commission to conduct the physical verification of the petitioners after examining the answer sheets, which bears the signature of the Invigilators, Attendance sheets which carries the photograph of the candidates, besides his signature as well as signature of the Invigilator in terms of order (Annexure P-10) dated 27.07.2018, passed by this Court in *CWP No.11761 of 2017* in case titled as '**Veena Yadav and others versus State of Haryana and others.**'

[2] Learned counsel contends that the petitioners had already submitted representations (Annexures P-11 & P-12) dated 19.10.2019, but the same have not been decided, till date and in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representations (Annexures P-11 & P-12) dated 19.10.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim, made in the representations (Annexures P-11 & P-12) dated 19.10.2019, in accordance with law, within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
